### **DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES**

Using the museum's library and resources, the intern will compile research related to an upcoming 2018 special exhibit on toy theaters at The National Museum of Toys and Miniatures. The intern is responsible for writing an annotated bibliography and a 6-10 page research paper about the topic. The intern will create an object list using the museum's object database, and will propose three ideas for educational programming based on their research findings. Additionally, the intern will meet weekly with the assistant educator to develop an exhibit planning document. The research intern will gain valuable experience in exhibit development, research, and writing.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

Graduate students and undergraduates who are in their senior year may apply. Candidates must have strong research skills and the proven ability to write annotated bibliographies and papers with high academic quality.
