

Making a Puppet of Oona Mouse

Activity for ages 6+. Adult supervision recommended.



Home puppet shows were very popular in the 18th through 20th centuries! Kids became the star of the stage, creating and performing plays for family and friends using puppets they made from many different types of materials. While one child moved the figures, another may have been busy changing backgrounds, reading a script, or using a music box to provide sound effects.

Use scissors to cut out the puppet of Oona Mouse. Then, attach it to a straw or popsicle stick with tape or school glue. Create an adventurous story for Oona Mouse and perform it for your family at home.
