DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES

Learning and Engagement interns will help facilitate the museum's summer programming, including the summer camp, drop-in activities, and tours. Interns must feel confident interacting with visitors of all ages and speaking in public. Interns will be provided with interpretive training

and best classroom management practices as part of the experience. Interns must convey professionalism at all times.

QUALIFICATIONS

Ideal applicants will have completed their sophomore year in college. Candidates must have strong interpersonal skills and have demonstrated experience public speaking and working with the public, especially children and families. Must be a self-starter with high professionalism, have exemplary problem-solving skills, and work well in a collaborative team environment. Students interested in education, art, museums, communications, psychology, history, and non-profit business are encouraged to apply.
